Fort Lauderdale Airport Terminal 1



The modernization of Concourse A in Terminal 1 was an extensive renovation and expansion project at the Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport. The new concourse added five new gates, a new Federal Inspection Services facility, meet-and-greet lobby, restaurants and retail.

The architectural jewel of the project is the sixty-five foot high, elliptical glass structure that offers a contemporary interior and exterior design with the latest technology in glass and glazing. Crawford-Tracey engineered, manufactured and installed ~100,000 sq.ft. of Pro-Tech 7SG and 9SG with insulating, laminated vision, spandrel and custom frit glass that met large missile impact requirements.
